HONOURS SCHOLARSHIPS

Two honours scholarships are available for studies in Humanities and Social Science disciplines for 2008 academic year. These are available on a competitive basis for enrolment within the following programs:

- Bachelor of Arts (Honours) (HH21)
- Bachelor of Social Science (Honours) (HH23)

Scholarship value

Each scholarship is worth \$3000 and will be awarded on merit. Two payments of \$1,500 each will be made during the Honours year, subject to satisfactory progress being made (pro rata for part-time students).

Eligibility

Students who have achieved a GPA of 5.5 or above (on a seven point scale) over their entire Bachelor of Arts or Bachelor of Social Science, or similar degrees from other universities, are eligible to apply. Particular attention will be given to the final two years of the degree. Mid-year entry students who are already enrolled in a HHS Honours course are also eligible to apply.

Conditions

- Scholarships will be awarded to students undertaking a dissertation in the fields of Humanities or Social Science.
- Award of scholarships will be determined primarily on the basis of academic merit.
- Students interested in applying for scholarships can obtain an application form from the School of Humanities and Human Services on Level 3, E Block, Carseldine Campus (also see below).

Note: Students who have completed Arts double degree programs are also eligible to apply for these scholarships. The GPA will be calculated on the results obtained in Arts units.

Application due dates

Completed scholarship application form (attached) must be submitted to School of Humanities and Human Services, Level 3, E Block, Carseldine Campus by 23rd November 2007.
